### The Bodily Resurrection of Christ (Part 3)

John 5:21-29

John 5:24 "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes Him who sent Me has eternal life and \_\_\_\_\_..."

John 5:28-29 "Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_"

John 11:25 "I am the Resurrection and the Life. He who believes in me will \_\_\_\_\_ even though he \_\_\_\_\_."

John 5:24 "... whoever hears my word and believes Him who sent Me has \_\_\_\_\_ life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life."
