**Full of Grace and Truth**

John 1:6-18

Ordinances that we practice

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None of them have the ability to \_\_\_\_\_ a person.

The ordinances \_\_\_\_\_ your commitment and \_\_\_\_\_ your soul as an act of grace.

Credo-baptism (Latin for \_\_\_\_\_ baptism) is different from paedobaptism. ( \_\_\_\_\_ baptism that depends on the belief of parents.

John 1:6-10 *“There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him. John was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light. The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him.”*

Who is the Light of the world? \_\_\_\_\_

John the Baptist was baptizing people – to proclaim that \_\_\_\_\_ was coming and people needed to be ready for His coming.

Vs. 11-13 *“[Jesus] came to his own, and his own people did not receive him. But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, He gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of \_\_\_\_\_.”*

Vs. 14 *“And the Word became flesh and \_\_\_\_\_ among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.”*

Vs. 15-16 *“John bore witness about him, and cried out, “This was He of whom I said, ‘He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was \_\_\_\_\_ me. For from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.”*

Definition of grace = That which you didn't earn or \_\_\_\_\_.

Vs. 17-18 *"For the law was given through \_\_\_\_\_; but grace and truth came through \_\_\_\_\_. No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, He has made him known."*

We know God through His \_\_\_\_\_.

Vs. 12-14. *"But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, He gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth."*

Everlasting God became a human \_\_\_\_\_.

Incarnation means God became \_\_\_\_\_.

God became a part of humanity and humanity through \_\_\_\_\_ becomes part of God's family.

Dwelt among = "He set up His \_\_\_\_\_ among us."

John 1:15 John the Baptist \_\_\_\_\_ about Christ.

John baptized with water, but Jesus baptized with the Holy \_\_\_\_\_.

Mark 1:9 *"In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit \_\_\_\_\_ on him like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."*

John 3:13 *"No one has stepped \_\_\_\_\_ into heaven, except the one who has stepped \_\_\_\_\_ from heaven, namely the Son of Man."*

Like the Holy Spirit descending upon Him at the beginning of His public ministry, so the Holy Spirit \_\_\_\_\_ our ministries after baptism.
