John 8:48-59

Who is Jesus?

Jesus was either a Liar, a Lunatic, or the Lord C.S. Lewis
Vs. 48 "The Jews answered him, "Are we not right in saying that you are a Samaritan and have a
demon?"
Vs. 50. "Yet I do not seek my own glory; there is One who seeks it, and he is the judge."
Vs. 51. "Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see
death."
Vs. 52-53 "The Jews said to him, "Now we know that you have a demon! Abraham died, as did the
prophets, yet you say, 'If anyone keeps my word, he will never taste death.' Are you greater than our
father Abraham, who died? And the prophets died! Who do you make yourself out to be?"
Vs. 53 The Jewish world view started with

whom you say, 'He is our God.'

Genesis 12 "Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's
country to the land that I will show you. And I will make you into a nation
and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing."
Vs. 55 "But you have known the Father in heaven. I know him. If I were to
say that I do not know him, I would be a liar like you, but I do know him and I keep his word.
Vs. 56 "Your father Abraham rejoiced that he would see He
saw it and was glad."
When Abraham's life was over and He went to heaven, who did he meet?

He met the second member of the godhead. This one would come to earth and is the Son of God. This is whom Father Abraham was putting his faith.

Romans 4:1-3 "What then shall we say was gained by Abraham, our forefather according to the flesh? For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness..."

Romans 4:20-25 "No unbelief made him waver concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong in his faith as he gave glory to God, fully convinced that God was able to do what he had promised. That is why his faith was "counted to him as righteousness." But the words "it was counted to him" were not written for his sake alone, but for ours also. It will be counted to us who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord, who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification."
