### Moses: Leaving fear for Faith

DEVOTIONALS FOR THE WEEK OF:

**June 14, 2026**

This week let's dig deeper on how to trade away fear for faith. What are you afraid of today? What does God say about our fear?

#### **Monday: Exodus 1:8-15; 2:1-3**

Why were Moses' parents afraid? How would you feel if there was an edict from the king that your baby had to die? What would you do to protect the child's life? What did Moses' parents do? Why was hiding the infant not a permanent solution? How long did they keep him hidden? What did they do when he became too loud to hide? What did she make out of the bulrushes? How did she make the basket waterproof? Did Moses' parents obey Pharaoh? What great heroic act did Moses' mother do that was faith based rather than fear based? Today, what are you afraid of? What small faith action can you do to help conquer the fear that you are feeling?

#### **Tuesday: Exodus 2:4-10; Hebrews 11:23**

What do you suppose Moses' family were feeling when they secretly placed his basket into the Nile River. Was that action assuring the safety of their son? Can you imagine the heart of his mother as she laid her son in the basket and pushed it away into the reeds? Who stayed behind to watch what would happen? Why might they have chosen this spot to cast their son into the Nile? Who came to that spot? If Pharaoh had given the order to kill this baby, what could have his daughter, the princess done? What did she do instead? Why? God's hand was on Miriam, Moses' sister. What did she dare do? What great blessing occurred next? Imagine Mose's mother's heart when she realized what Pharaoh's daughter was asking her to do? How long did the infant get to stay with his real mother? What do you suppose that she taught her son during these formative years? Today, thank God that he keeps His hand upon you even when life is getting scrambled and fear knocks on your door.

**Wednesday: Romans 16:20; 1 Corinthians 15:55-57**

Someone once said that if Satan can't keep us out of heaven then he will work at making us useless on earth. What are some ways that he tries to make us feel defeated? If he cannot keep us from believing in Christ for salvation, then the next best thing is to keep us from living in the victory of it. What is the relationship between God and Satan? Can the devil or his demonic hoards win a battle against God? What does it mean to you that Jesus "will soon crush Satan under their feet." Describe what will actually happen when Jesus is on the throne of your life. Today, claim the victory. Crush the head of our enemy so that he can no longer sting us.

**Thursday: Ephesians 2:6; Colossians 1:17, Matthew 28:18**

Why are you afraid today? What is discouraging you, where you see no escape? How is that making you feel? What does the Bible declare about you in terms of your proximity to God? Why do you think that the enemy of our soul wants to keep you in fear and bondage? What is the reality of his power over you if you are already spiritually "seated in the heavenly places with Christ." What does Colossian 1:17 mean to you? How powerful is God and His Word? Does the enemy have any authority over you? Today, declare victory over the devils schemes to hold you in bondage. Put yourself under the authority of the One (Jesus) who has been "given all authority in heaven and on earth."

**Friday: Romans 8:28; Isaiah 46:8-10;**

Sometimes Romans 8:28 is used when everything in life falls apart and fear sets in. What does it say about God? Why does good come out of our lives when things seem to be too great to control or change the way that we want it to change and it begins to fall apart? What is it about God that gives us faith when we are afraid? Is there anyone greater than God? What does He know about your life? Today call on His providential rule in your life.

**Saturday: Romans 8:35-39**

What does this passage teach us about fear? What in your life will separate you from God? What are we called when attacked? Why is that true? Even when it doesn't feel that way, remember that God has you firmly in His grip. And nothing can separate you from his love. Today no longer be a victim. Be the victor. Exchange your fear with faith. Whatever is your fear, God is there and is on His throne watching your life. Take a step of faith toward God. The enemy is already defeated.
