## Empty Tomb Appearances

John 20

Mark 16:3-4 – *“Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?”*

When they arrived - The stone closing the entrance was \_\_\_\_\_.

Mary ran to tell the others, “Someone has \_\_\_\_\_ the body of Jesus!”

Peter and his friend John \_\_\_\_\_ to see what they were talking about.

The evidence was there, but Mary did not \_\_\_\_\_ to see.

Vs. 4-5 John “\_\_\_\_\_ to look in” giving a \_\_\_\_\_ glance’.

Peter went into the tomb to carefully \_\_\_\_\_ the tomb

Vs. 6-7? The grave clothes were lying like a \_\_\_\_\_ around a body but the body was \_\_\_\_\_ there.

Mark 9:31 *“The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise.”*

John 20:8-9 They did \_\_\_\_\_ “that He must rise from the dead.”

When John entered the tomb he \_\_\_\_\_.

Mary returned but stood outside the tomb.

Luke 24:10-12 *“Now it was Mary Magdalene and Joanna and Mary the mother of James and the other women with them who told these things to the apostles, but these words seemed to them an idle tale, and they did not believe them. But Peter rose and ran to the tomb; stooping and looking in, he saw the linen cloths by themselves; and he went home marveling at what had happened.”*

Vs. 14 Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene but she did not recognize Him. *“Sir, if you have carried Him away, tell me where He is and I will take Him away.”*

Vs.16 *“Jesus said to her, “Mary.” She turned and said to him in Aramaic, “\_\_\_\_\_!”*

Vs. 19 Jesus appeared through the \_\_\_\_\_ doors and calmed their fears.

Vs. 21 *“Peace be with you. As the Lord has sent Me so I am \_\_\_\_\_ you.”*

Vs. 22 Jesus *“breathed on them and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit.”*

Verse 23 *“If you forgive the sins of any, they will be forgiven. If you withhold the forgiveness of sins, they will be withheld.”*

God forgives sin. But we have the \_\_\_\_\_ living in us.

If \_\_\_\_\_ forgives, we are to do likewise.

If God \_\_\_\_\_ the unrepentant, we should \_\_\_\_\_ forgive them.

Vs. 24. *"Now Thomas...was not with them when Jesu came."*

Vs. 25 I need \_\_\_\_\_. *"Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe."*

Vs. 28 *"My Lord and my God!"*

We have all the evidence that we need to believe in the \_\_\_\_\_.

Vs. 31 *"But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you might have life in His name."*
